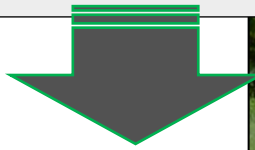

Steve Austin's Assessing and Handling Dangerous Dogs

The Programme

The morning session is aimed at those who may come in contact with dogs during their work, but are not generally required to directly handle dogs. It also provides a lead-in to the afternoon session. The morning session runs for three hours and addresses:

- Identifying and interpreting canine body language
- Avoiding an attack by a dog
- What to do in the case of a dog attack

The second session is aimed at those that may be required to interact directly with dogs during the performance of their duties. It runs for three hours and covers:

- Assessing personal protection and safety equipment needs
- Correct use of personal protection and safety equipment
- Safe and humane transporting of dogs
- WH&S issues when handling dogs
- Appropriate attire for working with dogs
- Breed Identification
- General safe handling practices
